

Sanner's Lake Woodstock Match Report - 9/15/2016

It was a beautiful late summer day in Southern Maryland with mild and moderately overcast weather making for excellent shooting at the September Woodstock match. A large group of competitors packed the firing line, with multiple Garands, Lee-Enfields, and '03 Springfields filling every station. There was also a Swedish Mauser and the old underdog M1 Carbine made a return appearance, going up against the big dogs at 100 yards.

Ling Xu and his M1 Garand were on fire as they tied the record high score of 295 for all three targets, and their awesome double-digit X-count shattered the tie to capture the high combined score of the year (so far). Congratulations to Ling! Chris Moe, the previous combined score leader (and current individual score leader), cruised to second place with his '03A3 Springfield, while the battle for third was a nail-biter that came right down to the wire. After struggling with a thumbscrew that came loose on the flip-floppy rear ladder sight, Mark Swierczek and his '03 Mark 1 Springfield came back strong against Joe Maida and his Swedish Mauser to tie things up on the third target, but the X count made the difference once again, propelling the Maida Mauser to a triumphant third place finish! All of the scores and a picture of the wall-to-wall firing line are included below.

Hats off to all the shooters for giving the old guns a chance to shine once again! The next Woodstock match is scheduled for October 20th assuming the daylight and weather hold out.
