Joe Mund felt the pressure rise as he continued to clear each row of egg targets...breathing a sigh of relief when the last one fell and he became our first shooter to clean the field and score a perfect 40! Congratulations to Joe! Sacrificing lunch to make the match, Jake Swierczek found that hunger pangs and precision shooting don't go well together but he still ended up with a strong 32 to take second place. New silhouette shooters David Stokes and Pat Farrar were neck and neck as they nailed targets at the closer distances but the challenge of knocking over tiny steel eggs at long distances spelled the difference, with David's 24 hits good enough for third place and Pat right behind him with 23 eggs toppled.
