Sanner's Lake Woodstock Match Report – June 2019

It was the last day of spring but the summer weather made an early arrival at Sanner's Lake bringing the heat and humidity with it...however, the oppressive climate didn't stop a full relay (and more!) of shooters from showing up and making a go of it at the June Woodstock match. Interesting rifles on the line included the usual gaggle of Garands, a 1903 Springfield as well as a No.4 Enfield, and we also saw several modern reproductions including an 1860 Henry chambered in .45 Colt made by the contemporary Henry Repeating Arms Company, as well as a replica of a late-50's style Cuban-pattern AR-10 sold by Brownells as the BRN-10. The battle for the top spots was tight, but in the end, the original classic rifles won the day, with the '03 Mark I Springfield of Mark Swierczek taking the top spot in both the combined and individual score categories with a 282-2X and 97-1X respectively. The battle for second place in the combined category was super tight, with the Lee-Enfield No. 4 Mk 2 of Paul Stephens (277-5X) slipping past Ron Ferguson's newly-built CMP Garand (277-4X) by a single bullseye! In the individual category, it was neck and neck near the top between Mark, Paul, and Ron, but the fine Winchester Garand of Asher Maroot managed to sneak in and grab third place with an excellent 94-2X.

Thanks to everyone for shrugging off the sweat and filling the benches to give the old warhorses a chance to bring the thunder once again. The next Woodstock match is on July 18th...see you there!
